On January 9, 2012, trial in the above-captioned matter commenced. The State of Iowa appeared by Assistant County Attorney Emily Nydle. The Defendant appeared personally and with counsel, Raphael Scheetz.

A jury was selected. Evidence was presented on January 9 and 10, 2012. The matter was submitted to the jury, and they retired for their deliberations at approximately 2:30 p.m. on January 10, 2012. At approximately 4:20 p.m. on January 10, 2012, the Court was advised that the jury had reached a verdict. The jury returned into open court at approximately 4:25 p.m. on January 10, 2012, with a verdict finding the Defendant, Tayzha Leikyn Musil, not guilty of the offense of Child Endangerment, in violation of Iowa Code Sections 726.6(7) and 726.6(1)(e), and the verdict was unanimous.

Counsel for the State and for the Defendant was asked if they wanted the jury to be polled, and neither party requested that the jury be polled. Thereafter, the jury was excused with the Court's thanks.

The jury's verdict, being in proper form, was accepted by the Court.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the verdict of the jury finding the Defendant, Tayzha Leikyn Musil, not guilty of the offense of Child Endangerment, in violation of Iowa Code Sections 726.6(7) and 726.6(1)(e) is hereby accepted.

The Clerk of the District Court is hereby ORDERED to file the verdict and enter this judgment of record. Based on the finding of the jury, this case is DISMISSED. Costs are assessed to the State.

Any prior bond posted by the Defendant is hereby exonerated.
